

**THE SCEPTRE SUNDAY FOOTBALL GUIDELINES AND
REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW CLUBS APPLYING TO JOIN LEAGUE.**

Clubs must be affiliated to Essex County F.A and the affiliation number confirmed to the League Secretary by July of the current year.

Clubs to provide a pitch within the area covered by the Sceptre League.

All club administration to be carried out in accordance with the Sceptre League Rules.

Clubs must ensure that all fines and invoices are paid within 14 days or will subject to further fines or suspension.

Clubs to provide 1st aid kits, and to ensure that Registration books are taken to every match.

Committee members make regular visits to matches to monitor teams and players. Violence and bad language will not be tolerated in the Sceptre League.

Clubs/players causing abuse to Referees or other clubs will be dealt with severely, the Sceptre League is part of the “Respect Campaign” incorporating all of its clubs.

Clubs must attend all League meetings, such as Referee nights, Registration meetings and A.G.M meeting. Clubs failing to attend will be fined.

Clubs are required to purchase 2 tickets per team, for the Annual Presentation Dinner when such dinner is held..

The approximate cost of entering the Sceptre League is :- £100.00 deposit £40.00 per annum membership fee, £10.00 cup entry fees, £4.00 per player registration fee.

The League provide Divisional Officers for each division, who clubs should contact with any queries, they will advise the club or pass them on to the League secretary or Chairman if required.

Any club that provides a “Sponsor” for the League, will have all of their player registration fees returned to them as an incentive. (Sponsorship cost £500.00)
